- Without these cookies, some parts of the Website will not function properly.

b) Optional Cookies: We only use these with your consent, unless otherwise permitted by law. These help us improve your experience but are not strictly necessary.

- **Performance & Functional Cookies:** Remember your preferences, such as language and login details, to make the Website more convenient.

- **Analytics Cookies:** Collect information about how users interact with the Website (pages visited, time spent, links clicked). We use this anonymized data to understand user behavior and improve our Website.
- **Advertising/Targeting Cookies:** These cookies are used to provide more relevant advertisements and content based on your interests, as well as to measure and improve the effectiveness of marketing campaigns.

3. Cookie Duration

We are committed to implementing responsible cookie storage practices to ensure your privacy and enhance your browsing experience. Below, we outline the different types of cookies we use and their respective durations:

(a) Session Cookies

Session cookies are temporary cookies that are deleted automatically when you close your browser. These cookies are used to maintain your session and ensure seamless navigation during your visit. They help us remember your actions from page to page, allowing you to navigate our website efficiently and securely without having to log in repeatedly.

(b) Persistent Cookies

Persistent cookies remain on your device for a specified period, even after you close your browser. These cookies remember your preferences and login details across multiple visits, making your experience more convenient and personalized. We typically limit the storage duration of these cookies to around 24 months. This means that after this period, the cookies will automatically expire and be deleted from your device.
